

The Discipline of Prayer Pt. 3

Matthew 6:9-13

9. "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.
10. 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.
11. 'Give us this day our daily bread.
12. 'And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
13. 'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil. [For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.]'

Luke 11:2-4

2. And He said to them, "When you pray, say: 'Father, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come.
3. 'Give us each day our daily bread.
4. 'And forgive us our sins, For we ourselves also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation.' "

Romans 8:15

For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

1 Peter 2:9

F	<p><u>Luke 17:20-21</u> 20. Now having been questioned by the Pharisees as to when the kingdom of God was coming, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God is not coming with signs to be observed; 21. nor will they say, 'Look, here <i>it is!</i>' or, 'There <i>it is!</i>' For behold, the kingdom of God is in your midst."</p> <p><u>Luke 17:20-21 (NKJV)</u> 20. Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation; 21. nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you."</p> <p><u>Matthew 6:33</u> "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."</p> <p><u>Matthew 4:17</u> From that time Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."</p>
S	<p><u>Psalms 103:20-21</u> 20. Bless the LORD, you His angels, Mighty in strength, who perform His word, Obeying the voice of His word! 21. Bless the LORD, all you His hosts, You who serve Him, doing His will.</p> <p><u>1 John 5:14-15</u> 14. This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. 15. And if we know that He hears us <i>in</i> whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.</p>
P	<p><u>Philippians 4:19</u> And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.</p> <p><u>Romans 8:32</u> He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?</p> <p><u>Matthew 6:33-34</u> 33. "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. 34. "So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.</p>

C	<p><u>1 John 1:8-10</u></p> <p>8. If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves and the truth is not in us. 9. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 10. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar and His word is not in us.</p> <p><u>Philippians 3:12</u></p> <p>Not that I have already obtained <i>it</i> or have already become perfect, but I press on so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus.</p> <p><u>Ephesians 4:32</u></p> <p>Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.</p>
G	<p><u>James 1:13-14</u></p> <p>13. Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, and He Himself does not tempt anyone. 14. But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust.</p> <p><u>Psalms 37:23-24</u></p> <p>23. The steps of a man are established by the LORD, and He delights in his way. 24. When he falls, he will not be hurled headlong, because the LORD is the One who holds his hand.</p> <p><u>1 Corinthians 10:13</u></p> <p>No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.</p>
