| 2 | <p><b><u>Psalm 24:1</u></b><br/>The earth is the LORD'S, and all it contains, the world, and those who dwell in it.</p>  |
| 3 | <p><b><u>Acts 17:24-28a</u></b><br/>24. "The God who made the world and all things in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands;<br/>25. nor is He served by human hands, as though He needed anything, since He Himself gives to all <i>people</i> life and breath and all things;<br/>26. and He made from one <i>man</i> every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined <i>their</i> appointed times and the boundaries of their habitation,<br/>27. that they would seek God, if perhaps they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us;<br/>28. for in Him we live and move and exist ...</p> <p><b><u>Colossians 1:13-16</u></b><br/>13. For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,<br/>14. in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.<br/>15. He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.<br/>16. For by Him all things were created, <i>both</i> in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him.</p> <p><b><u>1 Peter 1:18-19</u></b><br/>20. knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers,<br/>21. but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, <i>the blood</i> of Christ.</p> <p><b><u>Ephesians 1:20-23</u></b><br/>20. which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly <i>places</i>,<br/>21. far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come.<br/>22. And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church,<br/>23. which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.</p> <p><b><u>Acts 10:36</u></b><br/>"The word which He sent to the sons of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ (He is Lord of all)—</p> <p><b><u>Romans 10:12</u></b><br/>For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same <i>Lord</i> is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him;</p> |

| 6 | <p><b><u>1 Corinthians 4:2</u></b><br/>In this case, moreover, it is required of stewards that one be found trustworthy.</p>   |
| 7 | <p><b><u>1 Corinthians 4:1</u></b><br/>Let a man regard us in this manner, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.</p> <p><b><u>1 Corinthians 9:16-17</u></b><br/>16. For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for I am under compulsion; for woe is me if I do not preach the gospel.<br/>17. For if I do this voluntarily, I have a reward; but if against my will, I have a stewardship entrusted to me.</p> <p><b><u>Ephesians 3:2</u></b><br/>... if indeed you have heard of the stewardship of God's grace which was given to me for you;</p> <p><b><u>Colossians 1:25</u></b><br/>Of <i>this church</i> I was made a minister according to the stewardship from God bestowed on me for your benefit, so that I might fully carry out the <i>preaching of</i> the word of God,</p> |
| 8 | <p><b><u>Ephesians 5:15-17</u></b><br/>15. Therefore be careful how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise,<br/>16. making the most of your time, because the days are evil.<br/>17. So then do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.</p> <p><b><u>Colossians 4:5-6</u></b><br/>5. Conduct yourselves with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity.<br/>6. Let your speech always be with grace, <i>as though</i> seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person.</p>   |
| 9 | <p><b><u>1 Peter 4:10-11</u></b><br/>10. As each one has received a <i>special</i> gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.<br/>11. Whoever speaks, <i>is to do so</i> as one who is speaking the utterances of God; whoever serves <i>is to do so</i> as one who is serving by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever.
