

GOD IS HOLY

Isaiah 6:1-4

1. In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple.
2. Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.
3. And one called out to another and said, "Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts, the whole earth is full of His glory."
4. And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke.

Revelation 4:8

And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, are full of eyes around and within; and day and night they do not cease to say, "HOLY, HOLY, HOLY IS THE LORD GOD, THE ALMIGHTY, WHO WAS AND WHO IS AND WHO IS TO COME."

Psalm 99:1-3

1. The LORD reigns, let the peoples tremble; He is enthroned above the cherubim, let the earth shake!
2. The LORD is great in Zion, And He is exalted above all the peoples.
3. Let them praise Your great and awesome name; Holy is He.

Exodus 15:11

Who is like You among the gods, O LORD? Who is like You, majestic in holiness, awesome in praises, working wonders?

Isaiah 40:25

Numbers 20:1-13

1. Then the sons of Israel, the whole congregation, came to the wilderness of Zin in the first month; and the people stayed at Kadesh. Now Miriam died there and was buried there.
2. There was no water for the congregation, and they assembled themselves against Moses and Aaron.
3. The people thus contended with Moses and spoke, saying, "If only we had perished when our brothers perished before the LORD!
4. "Why then have you brought the LORD'S assembly into this wilderness, for us and our beasts to die here?"
5. "Why have you made us come up from Egypt, to bring us in to this wretched place? It is not a place of grain or figs or vines or pomegranates, nor is there water to drink."
6. Then Moses and Aaron came in from the presence of the assembly to the doorway of the tent of meeting and fell on their faces. Then the glory of the LORD appeared to them;
7. and the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
8. "Take the rod; and you and your brother Aaron assemble the congregation and speak to the rock before their eyes, that it may yield its water. You shall thus bring forth water for them out of the rock and let the congregation and their beasts drink."
9. So Moses took the rod from before the LORD, just as He had commanded him;
10. and Moses and Aaron gathered the assembly before the rock. And he said to them, "Listen now, you rebels; shall we bring forth water for you out of this rock?"
11. Then Moses lifted up his hand and struck the rock twice with his rod; and water came forth abundantly, and the congregation and their beasts drank.
12. But the LORD said to Moses and Aaron, "Because you have not believed Me, to treat Me as holy in the sight of the sons of Israel, therefore you shall not bring this assembly into the land which I have given them."
13. Those were the waters of Meribah, because the sons of Israel contended with the LORD, and He proved Himself holy among them.

Numbers 27:12-14

12. Then the LORD said to Moses, "Go up to this mountain of Abarim, and see the land which I have given to the sons of Israel.
13. "When you have seen it, you too will be gathered to your people, as Aaron your brother was;
14. for in the wilderness of Zin, during the strife of the congregation, you rebelled against My command to treat Me as holy before their eyes at the water." (These are the waters of Meribah of Kadesh in the wilderness of Zin.)

1 Samuel 4-6

2 Samuel 6:1-11

1. Now David again gathered all the chosen men of Israel, thirty thousand.
2. And David arose and went with all the people who were with him to Baale-judah, to bring up from there the ark of God which is called by the Name, the very name of the LORD of hosts who is enthroned above the cherubim.
3. They placed the ark of God on a new cart that they might bring it from the house of Abinadab which was on the hill; and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, were leading the new cart.
4. So they brought it with the ark of God from the house of Abinadab, which was on the hill; and Ahio was walking ahead of the ark.
5. Meanwhile, David and all the house of Israel were celebrating before the LORD with all kinds of instruments made of fir wood, and with lyres, harps, tambourines, castanets and cymbals.
6. But when they came to the threshing floor of Nacon, Uzzah reached out toward the ark of God and took hold of it, for the oxen nearly upset it.
7. And the anger of the LORD burned against Uzzah, and God struck him down there for his irreverence; and he died there by the ark of God.
8. David became angry because of the LORD'S outburst against Uzzah, and that place is called Perez-uzzah to this day.
9. So David was afraid of the LORD that day; and he said, "How can the ark of the LORD come to me?"
10. And David was unwilling to move the ark of the LORD into the city of David with him; but David took it aside to the house of Obed-edom the Gittite.
11. Thus the ark of the LORD remained in the house of Obed-edom the Gittite three months, and the LORD blessed Obed-edom and all his household.

6. Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs.
7. He touched my mouth with it and said, "Behold, this has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven."
8. Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!"
9. He said, "Go, and tell this people: 'Keep on listening, but do not perceive; Keep on looking, but do not understand.'
10. "Render the hearts of this people insensitive, Their ears dull, And their eyes dim, Otherwise they might see with their eyes, Hear with their ears, Understand with their hearts, And return and be healed."

Leviticus 11:45

'For I am the LORD who brought you up from the land of Egypt to be your God; thus you shall be holy, for I am holy.'

1 Peter 1:14-16

14. As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance,
15. but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all your behavior;
16. because it is written, "YOU SHALL BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY."

Hebrews 12:10b

... but He disciplines us for our good, so that we may share His holiness.

2 Corinthians 7:1

Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

Ephesians 1:4

... just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him.

Ephesians 5:27

... that He (*Jesus*) might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless.

1 John 3:3

... and everyone who has this hope fixed on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

Psalms 96:9

Worship the LORD in holy attire; Tremble before Him, all the earth.

Psalms 114:7

Tremble, O earth, before the Lord, before the God of Jacob,

13. But none of the rest dared to associate with them; however, the people held them in high esteem.
