### Psalm 25:10

All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth, To such as keep His covenant and His testimonies.

### Psalm 86:15

But You, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, Slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness and truth.

### Psalm 89:24

My faithfulness and My lovingkindness will be with him, And in My name his horn will be exalted.

### Psalm 100:5

For the LORD is good; His lovingkindness is everlasting And His faithfulness to all generations.

### Psalm 103:11

For as high as the heavens are above the earth, So great is His lovingkindness toward those who fear Him.

### Ephesians 3:18-19

18. *(that you)* may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth,  
19. and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God.

### Ephesians 2:4-5

4. But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,  
5. ... made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

### Psalm 136:1-2

1. Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good, For His lovingkindness is everlasting.  
2. Give thanks to the God of gods, For His lovingkindness is everlasting.

### Jeremiah 31:3

The LORD appeared to him from afar, saying, “I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore I have drawn you with lovingkindness.

### Micah 7:18

Who is a God like You, who pardons iniquity And passes over the rebellious act of the remnant of His possession?  
He does not retain His anger forever, Because He delights in unchanging love.

### James 1:17

Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow.

**John 3:16**

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

**Romans 5:8**

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

**Galatians 2:20**

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

**1 John 4:9-10**

9. By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him.
10. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

**Deuteronomy 10:15**

Yet on your fathers did the LORD set His affection to love them, and He chose their descendants after them, even you above all peoples, as it is this day.

**John 15:16**

You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you.

**Romans 5:8**

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

**Romans 9:13-16**

13. Just as it is written, “JACOB I LOVED, BUT ESAU I HATED.”
14. What shall we say then? There is no injustice with God, is there? May it never be!
15. For He says to Moses, “I WILL HAVE MERCY ON WHOM I HAVE MERCY, AND I WILL HAVE COMPASSION ON WHOM I HAVE COMPASSION.”
16. So then it does not depend on the man who wills or the man who runs, but on God who has mercy.

**Ephesians 2:4-7**

4. But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,
5. even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),
6. and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,
7. so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

**Ephesians 3:14-19**

14. For this reason I bow my knees before the Father,
15. from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name,
16. that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man,
17. so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love,
18. may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth,
19. and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God.

**Exodus 34:6-7**

6. Then the LORD passed by in front of him and proclaimed, “The LORD, the LORD God, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth;
7. who keeps lovingkindness for thousands, who forgives iniquity, transgression and sin; yet He will by no means leave the guilty unpunished, visiting the iniquity of fathers on the children and on the grandchildren to the third and fourth generations.”

**Isaiah 53:4-6**

4. Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted.
5. But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed.
6. All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him.

**1 Peter 2:24-25**

24. and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.
25. For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls.

**Leviticus 20:23**

Moreover, you shall not follow the customs of the nation which I will drive out before you, for they did all these things, and therefore I have abhorred them.

**Leviticus 26:30**

I then will destroy your high places, and cut down your incense altars, and heap your remains on the remains of your idols, for My soul shall abhor you.

**Deuteronomy 18:12**

For whoever does these things is detestable to the LORD; and because of these detestable things the LORD your God will drive them out before you.

**Psalm 5:4-5**

4. For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness; No evil dwells with You.
5. The boastful shall not stand before Your eyes; You hate all who do iniquity.

**Psalm 11:5**

The LORD tests the righteous and the wicked, And the one who loves violence His soul hates.

**John 3:16**

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

**John 3:36**

He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

**John 14:23**

Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our abode with him.

**Exodus 20:6**

... but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.

**Psalm 25:10**

He said, "O LORD, the God of Israel, there is no God like You in heaven above or on earth beneath, keeping covenant and showing lovingkindness to Your servants who walk before You with all their heart,

### Psalm 32:10

Many are the sorrows of the wicked, but he who trusts in the LORD, lovingkindness shall surround him.

### Psalm 86:5

For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, And abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon You.

### Psalm 103:11, 17

11. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, So great is His lovingkindness toward those who fear Him.

17. But the lovingkindness of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear Him, And His righteousness to children's children,

### Psalm 136

### 1 John 4:9

By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him.

### Matthew 5:43-48

43. You have heard that it was said, 'YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR and hate your enemy.'

44. But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,

45. so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven; for He causes His sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous.

46. For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same?

47. If you greet only your brothers, what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same?

48. Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

### John 15:7-12

7. If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

8. My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples.

9. Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you; abide in My love.

10. If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

11. These things I have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full.

12. This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.

### **1 John 3:10-11**

10. By this the children of God and the children of the devil are obvious: anyone who does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor the one who does not love his brother.
11. For this is the message which you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another;

### **2 Corinthians 5:14**

For the love of Christ controls us, having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all died;

### **1 John 2:9-11**

9. The one who says he is in the Light and yet hates his brother is in the darkness until now.
10. The one who loves his brother abides in the Light and there is no cause for stumbling in him.
11. But the one who hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know where he is going because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

### **1 John 3:14-17**

14. We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love abides in death.
15. Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer; and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.
16. We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us; and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.
17. But whoever has the world's goods, and sees his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him?

### **1 John 4:7-10**

7. Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.
8. The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love.
9. By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him.
10. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
