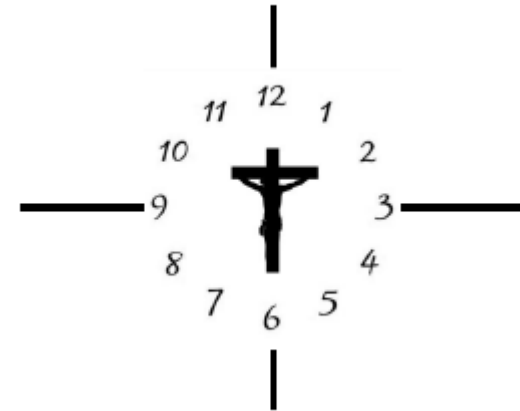
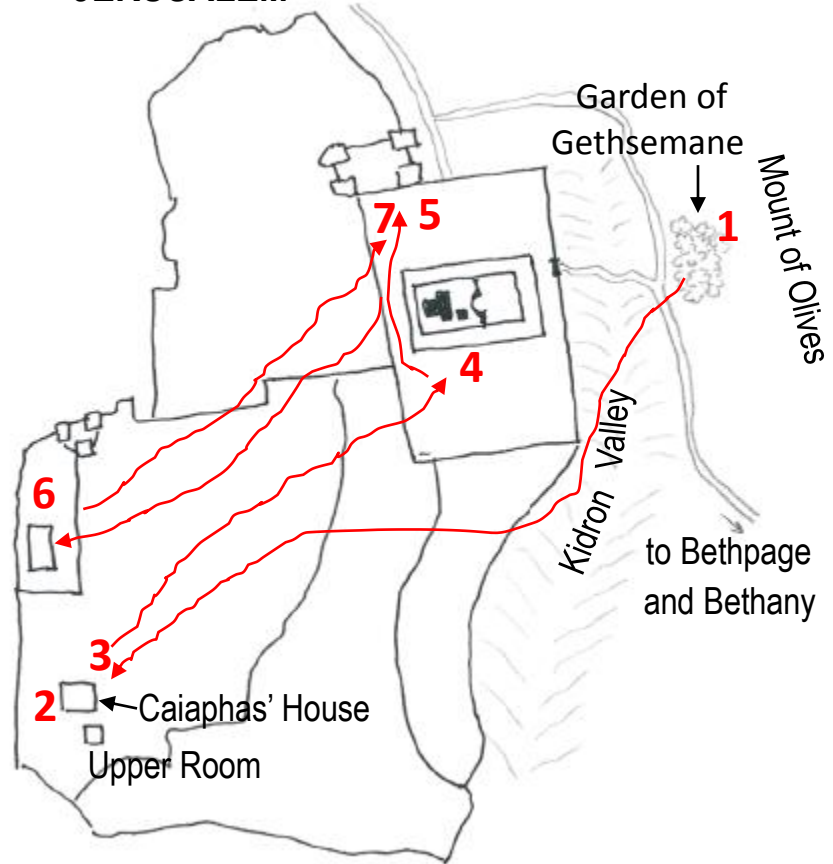


# JERUSALEM



Many Jewish regulations were broken in this process:

1. No trials were to be held during Passover week
2. Each member of the Sanhedrin was to vote individually
3. Jews had no authority to execute a person
4. Trials were not to be held at night
5. The accused was to be provided representation
