<p>18. the women report "all these things" to the disciples, who are mourning and weeping                      - Mary Magdalene tells them: "I have seen the Lord"</p> <p>19. the disciples refuse to believe that He is alive and that He has been seen                      - it seems to them to be nonsense</p> <p>20. Peter gets up and runs to the tomb again and returns marveling</p> <p>21. ③ Jesus appears to two disciples on their way to Emmaus                      - He appears in a "different form"                      - their eyes are prevented from recognizing Him                      - they had hoped He was going to redeem Israel                      - they knew the angels had said Jesus was alive                      - some had gone back to the tomb but none of them had seen Him                      - Jesus chastises them: "foolish men – slow to believe the prophets"                      - He explains to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures                      - He begins with Moses and all the prophets                      - their eyes are opened and they recognize Him                      - He vanishes from their sight</p> <p>22. the two return to Jerusalem and relate their experience to the eleven and those with them</p> <p>23. ④ Jesus <u>has</u> appeared to Simon Peter</p> <p>24. ⑤ in the evening Jesus comes and stands in the disciples' midst                      - Thomas is not present and he refuses to believe until he can see Jesus for himself</p>	<p>Jesus appears to:</p> <p>1. His disciples                      - after eight days – one week later                      - He invites Thomas to touch Him                      - Thomas' response:                      "My Lord and my God!"                      (John 20:26-29; 1 Cor. 15:5)</p> <p>2. <u>seven</u> of His disciples                      - at the Sea of Galilee                      - His 3<sup>rd</sup> appearance to His disciples                      - He questions Peter about his love for Him                      - Peter is to tend and shepherd Jesus' sheep                      - he is told by what kind of death he will glorify God                      (John 21:1-25)</p> <p>3. the eleven disciples                      - in Galilee on a mountain Jesus had designated                      - the "great commission"                      (Matt. 28:16-20)</p> <p>4. more than 500 believers at one time</p> <p>5. James, the brother of Jesus                      (1 Cor. 15:6-7)</p> <p>6. the apostles                      - over a period of 40 days                      - Jesus is taken up to heaven                      (Mk 16:14-20; Lk 24:44-49; Acts 1:1-3)</p>	<p>Jesus appears to:</p> <p>1. Saul                      - on the road to Damascus to persecute the believers                      - he is appointed a minister and a witness to the Gentiles                      (1 Cor. 15:8; Acts 9:1-25)</p> <p>2. Paul                      - after his conversion                      - Jesus, who appears to him reveals to him the one true gospel                      (Acts 26:15-18; Gal. 1:11-12)</p>
