

GOD’S RESPONSE TO SINNERS – Part 1

Romans 1:18–20

- 18.** For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,
19. because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them.
20. For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.

Romans 2:14-15

- 14.** For when Gentiles who do not have the Law do instinctively the things of the Law, these, not having the Law, are a law to themselves,
15. in that they show the work of the Law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness and their thoughts alternately accusing or else defending them,

Romans 1:32

... and although they know the ordinance of God, that those who practice such things are worthy of death, they not only do the same, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them.

James 4:15-17

- 15.** Instead, *you ought* to say, “If the Lord wills, we will live and also do this or that.”
16. But as it is, you boast in your arrogance; all such boasting is evil.
17. Therefore, to one who knows *the* right thing to do and does not do it, to him it is sin.

Psalms 51:4

Against You, You only, I have sinned and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are justified when You speak and blameless when You judge.

Romans 1:25

For they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.

Ezekiel 36:20

“When they came to the nations where they went, they profaned My holy name, because it was said of them, ‘These are the people of the LORD; yet they have come out of His land.’

Psalms 139:19-20

- 19.** O that You would slay the wicked, O God; depart from me, therefore, men of bloodshed.
20. For they speak against You wickedly, and Your enemies take *Your name* in vain.

Isaiah 52:5

“Now therefore, what do I have here,” declares the LORD, “seeing that My people have been taken away without cause?” *Again* the LORD declares, “Those who rule over them howl, and My name is continually blasphemed all day long.

Mark 3:29

... but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin”—

Romans 1:29-30

29. being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; *they are* gossips,
30. slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents,

Romans 2:23-24

23. You who boast in the Law, through your breaking the Law, do you dishonor God?
24. For "THE NAME OF GOD IS BLASPHEMED AMONG THE GENTILES BECAUSE OF YOU," just as it is written.

Ezekiel 18:24

"But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness, commits iniquity and does according to all the abominations that a wicked man does, will he live? All his righteous deeds which he has done will not be remembered for his treachery which he has committed and his sin which he has committed; for them he will die.

1 John 3:4

Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness.

Romans 1:21

For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Job 21:14-16

14. "They say to God, 'Depart from us! We do not even desire the knowledge of Your ways.
15. 'Who is the Almighty, that we should serve Him, and what would we gain if we entreat Him?'
16. "Behold, their prosperity is not in their hand; the counsel of the wicked is far from me.

2 Chronicles 12:14

He did evil because he did not set his heart to seek the LORD.

Jeremiah 5:22-24

22. 'Do you not fear Me?' declares the LORD. 'Do you not tremble in My presence? For I have placed the sand as a boundary for the sea, an eternal decree, so it cannot cross over it. Though the waves toss, yet they cannot prevail; though they roar, yet they cannot cross over it.
23. 'But this people has a stubborn and rebellious heart; they have turned aside and departed.
24. 'They do not say in their heart, "Let us now fear the LORD our God, who gives rain in its season, both the autumn rain and the spring rain, who keeps for us the appointed weeks of the harvest."

Romans 1:21

2 Timothy 3:2

For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy,

Psalms 119:21

You rebuke the arrogant, the cursed, who wander from Your commandments.

Isaiah 1:28

But transgressors and sinners will be crushed together, and those who forsake the LORD will come to an end.

Isaiah 48:4

Because I know that you are obstinate, and your neck is an iron sinew and your forehead bronze,

Psalm 78:8

and not be like their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation, a generation that did not prepare its heart and whose spirit was not faithful to God.

John 6:30

So they said to Him, “What then do You do for a sign, so that we may see, and believe You? What work do You perform?”

1 Corinthians 10:9

Nor let us try the Lord, as some of them did, and were destroyed by the serpents.

Ezekiel 8:12

Then He said to me, “Son of man, do you see what the elders of the house of Israel are committing in the dark, each man in the room of his carved images? For they say, ‘The LORD does not see us; the LORD has forsaken the land.’ ”

Deuteronomy 32:18

“You neglected the Rock who begot you, and forgot the God who gave you birth.

Psalm 68:1

Let God arise, let His enemies be scattered, and let those who hate Him flee before Him.

Isaiah 63:10

But they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit; therefore He turned Himself to become their enemy, He fought against them.

Hebrews 10:29

How much severer punishment do you think he will deserve who has trampled under foot the Son of God, and has regarded as unclean the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has insulted the Spirit of grace?

Acts 5:3, 9

3. But Peter said, “Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and to keep back *some* of the price of the land?

...

9. Then Peter *said* to her, “Why is it that you have agreed together to put the Spirit of the Lord to the test? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out *as well*.”

1 Thessalonians 5:19

Do not quench the Spirit;

Acts 7:51

You men who are stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears are always resisting the Holy Spirit; you are doing just as your fathers did.

Genesis 6:5-7

5. Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
6. The LORD was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart.
7. The LORD said, “I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, from man to animals to creeping things and to birds of the sky; for I am sorry that I have made them.”

Psalm 78:40

How often they rebelled against Him in the wilderness and grieved Him in the desert!

Isaiah 63:10

But they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit; therefore He turned Himself to become their enemy, He fought against them.

Ezekiel 6:9

Then those of you who escape will remember Me among the nations to which they will be carried captive, how I have been hurt by their adulterous hearts which turned away from Me, and by their eyes which played the harlot after their idols; and they will loathe themselves in their own sight for the evils which they have committed, for all their abominations.

Hosea 11:8

How can I give you up, O Ephraim? How can I surrender you, O Israel? How can I make you like Admah?
How can I treat you like Zeboim? My heart is turned over within Me, all My compassions are kindled.

Isaiah 43:24

You have bought Me not sweet cane with money, nor have you filled Me with the fat of your sacrifices; rather you have burdened Me with your sins, you have wearied Me with your iniquities.

Isaiah 1:14

I hate your new moon *festivals* and your appointed feasts, they have become a burden to Me; I am weary of bearing *them*.

Malachi 2:17

You have wearied the LORD with your words. Yet you say, “How have we wearied *Him*?” In that you say, “Everyone who does evil is good in the sight of the LORD, and He delights in them,” or, “Where is the God of justice?”

Amos 2:11-13

11. “Then I raised up some of your sons to be prophets and some of your young men to be Nazirites. Is this not so, O sons of Israel?” declares the LORD.
12. “But you made the Nazirites drink wine, and you commanded the prophets saying, ‘You shall not prophesy!’
13. “Behold, I am weighted down beneath you as a wagon is weighted down when filled with sheaves.
