

## **GOD'S RESPONSE TO SINNERS – Part 2**

### **Exodus 34:6**

Then the Lord passed by in front of him and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord God, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth;

### **Psalms 86:15**

But You, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness and truth.

### **Romans 2:4**

Or do you think lightly of the riches of His kindness and tolerance and patience, not knowing that the kindness of God leads you to repentance?

### **1 Kings 16:2**

Inasmuch as I exalted you from the dust and made you leader over My people Israel, and you have walked in the way of Jeroboam and have made My people Israel sin, provoking Me to anger with their sins,

### **1 Kings 14:9**

... you also have done more evil than all who were before you, and have gone and made for yourself other gods and molten images to provoke Me to anger, and have cast Me behind your back—

### **Jeremiah 8:19**

Behold, listen! The cry of the daughter of my people from a distant land: "Is the Lord not in Zion? Is her King not within her?" "Why have they provoked Me with their graven images, with foreign idols?"

### **John 3:36**

"He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

### **Ephesians 5:5–6**

- 5.** For this you know with certainty, that no immoral or impure person or covetous man, who is an idolater, has an inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God.
- 6.** Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.

### **Romans 1:18**

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

### **Jude 14–15**

- 14.** *It was* also about these men *that* Enoch, *in* the seventh *generation* from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord came with many thousands of His holy ones,
- 15.** to execute judgment upon all, and to convict all the ungodly of all their ungodly deeds which they have done in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."

**2 Chronicles 32:25**

But Hezekiah gave no return for the benefit he received, because his heart was proud; therefore wrath came on him and on Judah and Jerusalem.

**Matthew 23:27–28**

**27.** “Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which on the outside appear beautiful, but inside they are full of dead men’s bones and all uncleanness.

**28.** “So you, too, outwardly appear righteous to men, but inwardly you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness.

**Romans 1:18**

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

**Numbers 11:1**

Now the people became like those who complain of adversity in the hearing of the LORD; and when the LORD heard *it*, His anger was kindled, and the fire of the LORD burned among them and consumed *some* of the outskirts of the camp.

**Zechariah 7:9–12**

**9.** “Thus has the LORD of hosts said, ‘Dispense true justice and practice kindness and compassion each to his brother;

**10.** and do not oppress the widow or the orphan, the stranger or the poor; and do not devise evil in your hearts against one another.’

**11.** “But they refused to pay attention and turned a stubborn shoulder and stopped their ears from hearing.

**12.** “They made their hearts *like* flint so that they could not hear the law and the words which the LORD of hosts had sent by His Spirit through the former prophets; therefore great wrath came from the LORD of hosts.

**2 Kings 22:13**

“Go, inquire of the LORD for me and the people and all Judah concerning the words of this book that has been found, for great is the wrath of the LORD that burns against us, because our fathers have not listened to the words of this book, to do according to all that is written concerning us.”

**Exodus 15:7**

And in the greatness of Your excellence You overthrow those who rise up against You; You send forth Your burning anger, *and* it consumes them as chaff.

**Hebrews 12:29**

... for our God is a consuming fire.

**Deuteronomy 9:19**

For I was afraid of the anger and hot displeasure with which the LORD was wrathful against you in order to destroy you, but the LORD listened to me that time also.

**Psalms 90:11**

Who understands the power of Your anger and Your fury, according to the fear that is due You?

**Joshua 7:26**

They raised over him a great heap of stones that stands to this day, and the LORD turned from the fierceness of His anger. Therefore the name of that place has been called the valley of Achor to this day.

**Psalms 76:7**

You, even You, are to be feared; and who may stand in Your presence when once You are angry?

**Jeremiah 7:27-29**

27. “You shall speak all these words to them, but they will not listen to you; and you shall call to them, but they will not answer you.
28. “You shall say to them, ‘This is the nation that did not obey the voice of the LORD their God or accept correction; truth has perished and has been cut off from their mouth.
29. ‘Cut off your hair and cast *it* away, and take up a lamentation on the bare heights; for the LORD has rejected and forsaken the generation of His wrath.’

**Jeremiah 12:7-8**

7. “I have forsaken My house, I have abandoned My inheritance; I have given the beloved of My soul into the hand of her enemies.
8. “My inheritance has become to Me like a lion in the forest; she has roared against Me; therefore I have come to hate her.

**Psalms 5:4-5**

4. For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness; no evil dwells with You.
5. The boastful shall not stand before Your eyes; You hate all who do iniquity.

**Psalms 11:4-7**

4. The LORD is in His holy temple; the LORD’S throne is in heaven; His eyes behold, His eyelids test the sons of men.
5. The LORD tests the righteous and the wicked, and the one who loves violence His soul hates.
6. Upon the wicked He will rain snares; fire and brimstone and burning wind will be the portion of their cup.
7. For the LORD is righteous, He loves righteousness; the upright will behold His face.

**Leviticus 20:23**

‘Moreover, you shall not follow the customs of the nation which I will drive out before you, for they did all these things, and therefore I have abhorred them.

**Deuteronomy 18:12**

“For whoever does these things is detestable to the LORD; and because of these detestable things the LORD your God will drive them out before you.

**Titus 1:16**

They profess to know God, but by *their* deeds they deny *Him*, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed.

**Deuteronomy 25:16**

"For everyone who does these things, everyone who acts unjustly is an abomination to the LORD your God.

**Revelation 21:8**

"But for the cowardly and unbelieving and abominable and murderers and immoral persons and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars, their part *will be* in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

**Psalms 95:10**

"For forty years I loathed *that* generation, and said they are a people who err in their heart, and they do not know My ways.

**Nahum 1:3**

The LORD is slow to anger and great in power, and the LORD will by no means leave *the guilty* unpunished. In whirlwind and storm is His way, and clouds are the dust beneath His feet.

**Romans 2:5–6**

5. But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God,
6. who WILL RENDER TO EACH PERSON ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS:

**Habakkuk 1:13a**

Your eyes are too pure to approve evil, and You can not look on wickedness *with favor*. ...

**Habakkuk 3:2**

LORD, I have heard the report about You *and* I fear. O LORD, revive Your work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make it known; in wrath remember mercy.

**Jeremiah 33:5**

While *they* are coming to fight with the Chaldeans and to fill them with the corpses of men whom I have slain in My anger and in My wrath, and I have hidden My face from this city because of all their wickedness:

**Numbers 16:46**

Moses said to Aaron, "Take your censer and put in it fire from the altar, and lay incense *on it*; then bring it quickly to the congregation and make atonement for them, for wrath has gone forth from the LORD, the plague has begun!"

**2 Chronicles 12:7**

When the LORD saw that they humbled themselves, the word of the LORD came to Shemaiah, saying, "They have humbled themselves *so* I will not destroy them, but I will grant them some *measure* of deliverance, and My wrath shall not be poured out on Jerusalem by means of Shishak.

**Ezra 5:12**

But because our fathers had provoked the God of heaven to wrath, He gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, the Chaldean, *who* destroyed this temple and deported the people to Babylon.

**Psalms 88:7**

Your wrath has rested upon me, and You have afflicted me with all Your waves. Selah.

**Isaiah 29:6**

From the LORD of hosts you will be punished with thunder and earthquake and loud noise, *with* whirlwind and tempest and the flame of a consuming fire.

**Jeremiah 10:10**

But the LORD is the true God; He is the living God and the everlasting King. At His wrath the earth quakes, and the nations cannot endure His indignation.

**Ezekiel 38:19**

“In My zeal and in My blazing wrath I declare *that* on that day there will surely be a great earthquake in the land of Israel.

**Acts 5:5–10**

**5.** And as he heard these words, Ananias fell down and breathed his last; and great fear came over all who heard of it.

...

**10.** And immediately she fell at his feet and breathed her last, and the young men came in and found her dead, and they carried her out and buried her beside her husband.

**Zephaniah 1:15, 18**

**15.** A day of wrath is that day, a day of trouble and distress, a day of destruction and desolation, a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and thick darkness,

...

**18.** Neither their silver nor their gold will be able to deliver them on the day of the LORD'S wrath; and all the earth will be devoured in the fire of His jealousy, for He will make a complete end, indeed a terrifying one, of all the inhabitants of the earth.

**Amos 5:18–20**

**18.** Alas, you who are longing for the day of the LORD, for what purpose *will* the day of the LORD *be* to you? It *will be* darkness and not light;

**19.** As when a man flees from a lion and a bear meets him, or goes home, leans his hand against the wall and a snake bites him.

**20.** *Will* not the day of the LORD *be* darkness instead of light, even gloom with no brightness in it?

**Jeremiah 23:20**

“The anger of the LORD will not turn back until He has performed and carried out the purposes of His heart; in the last days you will clearly understand it.

**Jeremiah 30:24**

The fierce anger of the LORD will not turn back until He has performed and until He has accomplished the intent of His heart;

In the latter days you will understand this.

**Leviticus 26:28**

... then I will act with wrathful hostility against you, and I, even I, will punish you seven times for your sins.

**Romans 9:22–24**

- 22.** What if God, although willing to demonstrate His wrath and to make His power known, endured with much patience vessels of wrath prepared for destruction?
- 23.** And He did so to make known the riches of His glory upon vessels of mercy, which He prepared beforehand for glory,
- 24.** even us, whom He also called, not from among Jews only, but also from among Gentiles.

**Isaiah 59:18–19**

- 18.** According to *their* deeds, so He will repay, wrath to His adversaries, recompense to His enemies; to the coastlands He will make recompense.
- 19.** So they will fear the name of the LORD from the west and His glory from the rising of the sun, for He will come like a rushing stream which the wind of the LORD drives.

**Ezekiel 38:22–23**

- 22.** “With pestilence and with blood I will enter into judgment with him; and I will rain on him and on his troops, and on the many peoples who are with him, a torrential rain, with hailstones, fire and brimstone.
- 23.** “I will magnify Myself, sanctify Myself, and make Myself known in the sight of many nations; and they will know that I am the LORD.”
