Romans 3:23

... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Isaiah 64:6

For all of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment; and all of us wither like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

Romans 1:18

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

Romans 8:7-8

7. because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able *to do so*,
8. and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

John 6:44

No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day.

Romans 6:23

... For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Ezekiel 18:4

Behold, all souls are Mine; the soul of the father as well as the soul of the son is Mine. The soul who sins will die.

2 Thessalonians 1:8-9

8. ... dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.
9. These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power,

Revelation 20:15

And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

1 John 4:8

The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

John 3:16

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Psalms 36:7

How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God! And the children of men take refuge in the shadow of Your wings.

Psalms 106:1

Praise the Lord! Oh give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His lovingkindness is everlasting.

1 Chronicles 16:34

O give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His lovingkindness is everlasting.

Psalms 86:5

For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, and abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon You.

Psalms 145:8

The Lord is gracious and merciful; slow to anger and great in lovingkindness.

Titus 3:5

He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,

Isaiah 63:9

In all their affliction He was afflicted, and the angel of His presence saved them; in His love and in His mercy He redeemed them, and He lifted them and carried them all the days of old.

Psalm 145:8

The Lord is gracious and merciful; slow to anger and great in lovingkindness.

Jeremiah 3:12

Go and proclaim these words toward the north and say, ‘Return, faithless Israel,’ declares the Lord; ‘I will not look upon you in anger. For I am gracious,’ declares the Lord; ‘I will not be angry forever.

Psalm 25:11

For Your name's sake, O Lord, Pardon my iniquity, for it is great.

Psalm 4:1

Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in my distress; be gracious to me and hear my prayer.

Exodus 15:11

“Who is like You among the gods, O Lord? Who is like You, majestic in holiness, awesome in praises, working wonders?”

Proverbs 9:10

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

Psalm 5:4

For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness; no evil dwells with You.

Psalm 92:15

To declare that the Lord is upright; *He is* my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.

1 John 1:5

This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.

2 Chronicles 12:6

So the princes of Israel and the king humbled themselves and said, “The Lord is righteous.”

Psalm 33:5

He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the lovingkindness of the Lord.

Psalm 45:6

Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of uprightness is the scepter of Your kingdom.

Deuteronomy 10:17

For the Lord your God is the God of gods and the Lord of lords, the great, the mighty, and the awesome God who does not show partiality nor take a bribe.

Deuteronomy 32:4

The Rock! His work is perfect, for all His ways are just; a God of faithfulness and without injustice, righteous and upright is He.

Isaiah 61:8

For I, the Lord, love justice, I hate robbery in the burnt offering; and I will faithfully give them their recompense and make an everlasting covenant with them.

Genesis 18:25

Far be it from You to do such a thing, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous and the wicked are *treated* alike. Far be it from You! Shall not the Judge of all the earth deal justly?”

Proverbs 17:15

He who justifies the wicked and he who condemns the righteous, both of them alike are an abomination to the Lord.

Galatians 4:4

But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law,

Philippians 2:5-8

5. Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,
6. who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,
7. but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men.
8. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Acts 2:23

... this *Man*, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put Him to death.

2 Corinthians 5:21

He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Galatians 3:13

Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, “CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE”—

Matthew 27:46

About the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “ELI, ELI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?” that is, “MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?”

Romans 3:23-26

23. for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
24. being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;
25. whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. *This was* to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;
26. for the demonstration, *I say*, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.
