

## Dealing with False Teachers – Pt 1

### Acts 20:29-30

29. "I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock;  
30. and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them.

### 1 Timothy 4:1-3

1. But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons,
2. by means of the hypocrisy of liars seared in their own conscience as with a branding iron,
3. *men* who forbid marriage *and* *advocate* abstaining from foods which God has created to be gratefully shared in by those who believe and know the truth.

### 1 2 Timothy 4:1-4

1. I solemnly charge *you* in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom:
2. preach the word; be ready in season *and* out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.
3. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but *wanting* to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires,
4. and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths.

### 2 Corinthians 2:17

For we are not like many, peddling the word of God, but as from sincerity, but as from God, we speak in Christ in the sight of God.

### Titus 2:7-8 NIV

7. In everything set them an example by doing what is good. In your teaching show integrity, seriousness
8. and soundness of speech that cannot be condemned, so that those who oppose you may be ashamed because they have nothing bad to say about us.

### 1 Timothy 4:16

Pay close attention to yourself and to your teaching; persevere in these things, for as you do this you will ensure salvation both for yourself and for those who hear you.

### 2 ↓ 2 Timothy 1:13

Retain the standard of sound words which you have heard from me, in the faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.

### Titus 2:1

But as for you, speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine.

### Hebrews 13:9a

Do not be carried away by varied and strange teachings; ...

↑ 2	<p><b><u>2 Timothy 2:15</u></b> Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.</p> <p><b><u>Psalm 119:104</u></b> From Your precepts I get understanding; therefore I hate every false way.</p> <p><b><u>Psalm 119:163</u></b> I hate and despise falsehood, <i>but</i> I love Your law.</p> <p><b><u>Proverbs 13:5a</u></b> A righteous man hates falsehood, but a wicked man acts disgustingly and shamefully.</p>
3	<p><b><u>James 3:1</u></b> Let not many <i>of you</i> become teachers, my brethren, knowing that as such we will incur a stricter judgment.</p>
6 ↓	<p><b><u>Galatians 5:2, 4</u></b> 2. Behold I, Paul, say to you that if you receive circumcision, Christ will be of no benefit to you. ... 4. You have been severed from Christ, you who are seeking to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace.</p> <p><b><u>2 Peter 2:2</u></b> Many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of the truth will be maligned;</p> <p><b><u>1 Timothy 1:4 NIV</u></b> ... nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies. These promote controversies rather than God's work—which is by faith</p> <p><b><u>Romans 16:17-18</u></b> 17. Now I urge you, brethren, keep your eye on those who cause dissensions and hindrances contrary to the teaching which you learned, and turn away from them. 18. For such men are slaves, not of our Lord Christ but of their own appetites; and by their smooth and flattering speech they deceive the hearts of the unsuspecting.</p> <p><b><u>Galatians 4:17 NIV</u></b> Those people are zealous to win you over, but for no good. What they want is to alienate you from us, so that you may be zealous for them</p> <p><b><u>Galatians 1:7</u></b> ... which is <i>really</i> not another (<i>gospel</i>); only there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the gospel of Christ.</p>

**Galatians 3:1**

You foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified?

**Galatians 5:1**

It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore keep standing firm and do not be subject again to a yoke of slavery.

**Galatians 5: 12**

I wish that those who are troubling you would even mutilate themselves.

**Ephesians 4:14**

6 As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming;

**2 Thessalonians 2:2**

... that you not be quickly shaken from your composure or be disturbed either by a spirit or a message or a letter as if from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come.

**2 Timothy 2:14**

Remind *them* of these things, and solemnly charge *them* in the presence of God not to wrangle about words, which is useless and leads to the ruin of the hearers.
