10	<p>apostle – “<i>apostolos</i>” (652) – apostle; a messenger; one sent forth with orders – does not refer to the <i>office</i> of Apostle (the 12 uniquely held the office – the gift continues)</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- to- to- to
11	<p>teaching – “<i>didaskalos</i>” (1320) – an instructor; teacher – “... teachers will incur a stricter judgment” (James 3:1)</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- to- to- to
12	<p>helps – “<i>antilempsis</i>” (484) – help; render assistance</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- to- to- to
