

<b>The Spiritual Gifts</b>	
<b>1</b>	<p><b>word</b> – “<i>logos</i>” (3056) – a word (as embodying an idea), a statement, speech  <b>wisdom</b> – “<i>sophia</i>” (4678) – wisdom; prudence, discretion, insight into the nature of things</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to <b>apply the truth of the Word of God to everyday life</b></li> <li>- to <b>understand truth and godliness and as a result to act and counsel wisely</b></li> <li>- to <b>help an individual or a congregation to obtain God-glorifying goals</b></li> </ul>
<b>2</b>	<p><b>word</b> – “<i>logos</i>” (3056) – a word (as embodying an idea), a statement, speech  <b>knowledge</b> – “<i>gnosis</i>” (1108) – a knowing; understanding, perception, comprehension</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to <b>investigate and inquire of God’s Word</b></li> <li>- to <b>discover, accumulate, analyze and clarify the information and ideas of truth</b></li> <li>- to <b>systematize and categorize the facts and details from the Word of God</b></li> </ul>
<b>3</b>	<p><b>faith</b> – “<i>pistis</i>” (4102) – faith; complete trust; confidence; conviction; assurance; certainty                      – not saving faith but rather “mountain moving” faith (1 Cor. 13:1)</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to <b>believe unshakably that God will do what He has promised</b></li> <li>- to <b>believe that with God nothing is ever impossible, in spite of appearances to the contrary</b></li> <li>- to <b>take God at His Word and expect Him to move</b></li> </ul>
<b>4</b>	<p><b>gifts</b> – “<i>charisma</i>” (5486) – (plural) a gift of grace; a free gift, not on the basis of merit  <b>healings</b> – “<i>iama</i>” (2386) – (plural) healing, the results of the acts</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to <b>heal in certain situations</b></li> <li>- to <b>bring or release healing to a person in his body or soul</b></li> <li>- the double plural seems to mean that these gifts <b>were not permanently available at the will of the gifted believer</b></li> </ul>

<p><b>5</b></p>	<p><b>effecting</b> – “<i>energema</i>” (1755) – (plural) working; activity; operation  <b>miracles</b> – “<i>dunamis</i>” (1411) – (plural) miraculous power, mighty deeds, wonders</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to perform miracles (workings of power) in certain situations</li> </ul>
<p><b>6</b></p>	<p><b>prophecy</b> – “<i>propheteia</i>” – (4394) – a speaking forth of God’s message; to tell forth the mind and counsel of God (1 Cor. 14:3)</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to speak forth the mind and counsel of God, to give a timely message</li> <li>- to make God’s heart known</li> <li>- to speak God’s words for edification, exhortation and consolation</li> </ul>
<p><b>7</b></p>	<p><b>distinguishings</b> – “<i>diakrisis</i>” (1253) – (plural) to discriminate; a discerning clearly  <b>spirits</b> – “<i>pneuma</i>” (4151) – (plural) a spirit; a spirit being or power</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to know what is from God and what is not</li> <li>- to discern truth from error</li> <li>- to judge or appraise a person to keep the church from being led astray by false teachers</li> </ul>
<p><b>8</b></p>	<p><b>various kinds</b> – “<i>genos</i>” (1085) – sort; kind  <b>tongues</b> – “<i>glossa</i>” (1100) – the tongue; languages          – “... and no kind (of language in the world) is without meaning” (1 Cor. 14:10)</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to speak a language not previously learned</li> </ul>
<p><b>9</b></p>	<p><b>interpretation</b> – “<i>hermeneia</i>” (2058) – interpretation; translation  <b>tongues</b> – “<i>glossa</i>” – same as above</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to interpret or translate a language not learned, but known to people</li> </ul>

<b>10</b>	<p><b>apostle</b> – “<i>apostolos</i>” (652) – apostle; a messenger; one sent forth with orders – does not refer to the <i>office</i> of Apostle (the 12 uniquely held the office – the gift continues)</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to church plant as one sent on a mission; begin a new work or ministry</li><li>- to establish churches where the gospel has not been preached</li><li>- to reach across cultures and take risks in challenging environments</li></ul>
<b>11</b>	<p><b>teaching</b> – “<i>didaskalos</i>” (1320) – an instructor; teacher – “... teachers will incur a stricter judgment” (James 3:1)</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to communicate spiritual truth in a clear and understandable way</li><li>- to explain and expound the Word of God</li><li>- to study and understand the truths of God’s Word</li></ul>
<b>12</b>	<p><b>helps</b> – “<i>antilempsis</i>” (484) – help; render assistance</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to lend assistance in a general way</li><li>- to lay hold of something in order to relieve or support others</li><li>- to free up others to use their gifts to the fullest</li></ul>
<b>13</b>	<p><b>administration</b> – “<i>kubernesis</i>” (2941) – (verb = to steer); leading; governing – used of the pilot of a ship, shipmaster (Acts 27:11; Rev 18:17)</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to organize, direct and implement plans to lead others in the various ministries of the church</li><li>- to be focused on the goal and concerned with details</li></ul>
<b>14</b>	<p><b>service</b> – “<i>diakonia</i>” (1248) – service; help; ministry; support; “deacon”</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to do for others whatever needs to be done without notice or earthly reward</li><li>- to provide assistance in a specific or official way</li><li>- to serve in ways that benefit others with more “public” gifts and ministries</li><li>- to render specific service to a ministry or person (John Mark, Timothy)</li></ul>

<b>15</b>	<p><b>exhortation</b> – “<i>paraklesis</i>” (3874) – a calling to one’s side, i.e. encouragement</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to encourage, to come alongside, to aid, to strengthen</li><li>- to console or entreat as well as admonish</li><li>- to motivate others to the obedience of truth</li></ul>
<b>16</b>	<p><b>giving</b> – “<i>metadidomi</i>” (3330) – to give a share of; give; impart</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to give financial resources with liberality and great joy</li><li>- to supply for specific needs of the church and its ministries and missionaries</li><li>- to know that God will supply all needs and richly bless in the giving</li><li>- to give sincerely, generously and without pretense or hypocrisy</li></ul>
<b>17</b>	<p><b>leadership</b> – “<i>proistemi</i>” (4291) – to rule; have authority over; manage; to stand before</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to “stand before” – to see the big picture and have people follow</li><li>- to preside over and rank over others</li><li>- to set goals in accordance with God’s purpose, to communicate these goals to others so they voluntarily and harmoniously work together to accomplish those goals for the glory of God</li></ul>
<b>18</b>	<p><b>mercy</b> – “<i>eleeo</i>” (1653) – to show mercy, to help one afflicted or seeking aid; bring help to the wretched</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to love and help those who are “down and out”, the distressed and suffering who cannot help themselves</li><li>- to have pity and compassion and to do something about it cheerfully</li><li>- to overlook the external</li></ul>

<b>19</b>	<p><b>evangelism</b> – “<i>euaggelistes</i>” (2099) – an evangelist; one who brings good tidings, good news</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to share the gospel clearly and effectively with the lost</li><li>- to overcome the normal fear of rejection and engage non-believers in conversations about Jesus</li><li>- to teach other believers how to lead the lost to Christ</li></ul>
<b>20</b>	<p><b>pastor</b> – “<i>poimen</i>” (4166) – a shepherd; one who tends herds or flocks, a pastor</p> <p><b>teacher</b> – “<i>didaskalos</i>” – same as above</p> <p>The supernatural ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to shepherd – to protect, tend and feed the flock of God</li><li>- to assume a long-term personal responsibility for the welfare of a group of believers</li><li>- to give instruction, teach and train</li></ul>
