3	<p><u>1 Peter 4:10-11</u></p> <p>10. As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.</p> <p>11. Whoever speaks, is to do so as one who is speaking the utterances of God; whoever serves is to do so as one who is serving by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.</p> <p><u>Revelation 4:11</u></p> <p>“Worthy are You, our Lord and our God, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and because of Your will they existed, and were created.”</p> <p><u>Colossians 1:16</u></p> <p>For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him.</p>
4	<p><u>1 Corinthians 13:1-3</u></p> <p>1. If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.</p> <p>2. If I have the gift of prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.</p> <p>3. And if I give all my possessions to feed the poor, and if I surrender my body to be burned, but do not have love, it profits me nothing.</p> <p><u>1 Corinthians 14:39-40</u></p> <p>39. Therefore, my brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak in tongues.</p> <p>40. But all things must be done properly and in an orderly manner.</p>
8	<p><u>Ephesians 1:4</u></p> <p>...just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love</p> <p><u>Ephesians 2:8-10</u></p> <p>8. For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God;</p> <p>9. not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.</p> <p>10. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.</p> <p><u>2 Timothy 3:16-17</u></p> <p>16. All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;</p> <p>17. so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.</p>
