

## Church Rites: The Lord's Supper Pt 1

2	<p><b><u>Acts 2:42</u></b> They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.</p> <p><b><u>1 Corinthians 10:16</u></b> Is not the cup of blessing which we bless a sharing in the blood of Christ? Is not the bread which we break a sharing in the body of Christ?</p> <p><b><u>Luke 22:13-16</u></b> 13. And they left and found everything just as He had told them; and they prepared the Passover. 14. When the hour had come, He reclined at the table, and the apostles with Him. 15. And He said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; 16. for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God."</p>
3	<p><b><u>1 Corinthians 10:16 NKJV</u></b> The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?</p>
4	<p><b><u>1 Corinthians 10:21</u></b> You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons; you cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons.</p> <p><b><u>1 Corinthians 11:20-21</u></b> 20. Therefore when you meet together, it is not to eat the Lord's Supper, 21. for in your eating each one takes his own supper first; and one is hungry and another is drunk.</p>
5	<p><b><u>1 Corinthians 11:23-24</u></b> 23. For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; 24. and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me."</p>

	<p><b><u>Mark 14:12-16</u></b> 12. On the first day of Unleavened Bread, when the Passover lamb was being sacrificed, His disciples said to Him, "Where do You want us to go and prepare for You to eat the Passover?" 13. And He sent two of His disciples and said to them, "Go into the city, and a man will meet you carrying a pitcher of water; follow him; 14. and wherever he enters, say to the owner of the house, 'The Teacher says, "Where is My guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?"' ' 15. "And he himself will show you a large upper room furnished and ready; prepare for us there." 16. The disciples went out and came to the city, and found it just as He had told them; and they prepared the Passover.</p> <p><b><u>Luke 22:14-20</u></b> * 14. When the hour had come, He reclined at the table, and the apostles with Him. 15. And He said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer; 16. for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." 17. And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He said, "Take this and share it among yourselves; 18. for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine from now on until the kingdom of God comes." 19. And when He had taken some bread and given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 20. And in the same way He took the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood.</p>
1	<p><b><u>Exodus 12:14</u></b> Now this day will be a memorial to you, and you shall celebrate it as a feast to the LORD; throughout your generations you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance.</p> <p><b><u>Exodus 34:25</u></b> You shall not offer the blood of My sacrifice with leavened bread, nor is the sacrifice of the Feast of the Passover to be left over until morning.</p>
2a ↓	<p><b><u>John 1:29</u></b> The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!</p> <p><b><u>1 Corinthians 5:7</u></b> Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed.</p> <p><b><u>Exodus 12:5</u></b> Your lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old; you may take it from the sheep or from the goats.</p>

↑ 2a	<p><b><u>1 Peter 1:18-19</u></b> 18. knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, 19. but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.</p> <p><b><u>Hebrews 4:15</u></b> For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin.</p> <p><b><u>Mark 14:12</u></b> On the first day of Unleavened Bread, when the Passover lamb was being sacrificed, His disciples said to Him, "Where do You want us to go and prepare for You to eat the Passover?"</p>
2b	<p><b><u>Hebrews 9:11-14</u></b> 11. But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things to come, He entered through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation; 12. and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. 13. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh, 14. how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?</p> <p><b><u>Romans 6:23</u></b> For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.</p> <p><b><u>Romans 8:2</u></b> For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death.</p>
2c	<p><b><u>1 Corinthians 5:6-8</u></b> 6. Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump of dough? 7. Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed. 8. Therefore let us celebrate the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.</p> <p><b><u>Galatians 5:9</u></b> A little leaven leavens the whole lump of dough.</p>
