The <u>REDEMPTION PRICE</u> was calculated based on the value of the slave's work and the number of years remaining until the next Jubilee (every 50<sup>th</sup> year) (Lev 25:50-52)</p> <p>➔ the price required for our redemption was blood; without blood there is no forgiveness</p> <p>✝ Jesus paid the price – His blood                      - of a spotless, unblemished Lamb                      - more precious than perishable things like silver or gold                      (Heb 9:22; Lev 17:11; 1 Pe 1:18-19)</p> <p>7. The GO'EL could also redeem (purchase or buy back) property (Lev 25:23-25)</p> <p>✝ Jesus, because He was slain, was worthy to restore the property rights to the earth, created by God for mankind but forfeited by Adam (sin)                      (Rev 5; Rev 11:15-17; Mt 5:5)</p> <p>8. Another of the GO'EL's vital responsibilities was to avenge the shedding of innocent blood - he was also called the GO'EL HADAM, the blood avenger (Nu 35:12, 33-34; Josh 20:3, 9)</p> <p>✝ during the tribulation time Jesus will avenge the blood of all the prophets saints and bond-servants of God                      (Rev 6:10; 16:6; 19:2)</p>	<p>Many are the blessings of our redemption!</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
