Redemption – The KINSMAN REDEEMER (the GO'EL)	
3	<p><b><u>Proverbs 5:22</u></b>                      His own iniquities will capture the wicked, and he will be held with the cords of his sin.</p> <p><b><u>2 Peter 2:19</u></b>                      ... promising them freedom while they themselves are slaves of corruption; for by what a man is overcome, by this he is enslaved.</p> <p><b><u>Romans 6:16</u></b>                      Do you not know that when you present yourselves to someone <i>as</i> slaves for obedience, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin resulting in death, or of obedience resulting in righteousness?</p> <p><b><u>Hebrews 2:15</u></b>                      .. and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives.</p> <p><b><u>Acts 26:18</u></b>                      ... to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.'</p> <p><b><u>Galatians 1:4</u></b>                      ... who gave Himself for our sins so that He might rescue us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,</p>
4	<p><b><u>Psalm 49:7-8</u></b>                      7. No man can by any means redeem <i>his</i> brother or give to God a ransom for him—                      8. For the redemption of his soul is costly, and he should cease <i>trying</i> forever—</p>
5	<p><b><u>1 Peter 2:22</u></b>                      WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH;</p> <p><b><u>2 Corinthians 5:21</u></b>                      He made Him who knew no sin <i>to be</i> sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.</p> <p><b><u>1 John 3:5</u></b>                      You know that He appeared in order to take away sins; and in Him there is no sin.</p>

5	c	<p><b><u>Philippians 2:6-8</u></b> 6. who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7. but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, <i>and</i> being made in the likeness of men. 8. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.</p> <p><b><u>Hebrews 2:14-15</u></b> 14. Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, 15. and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives.</p> <p><b><u>John 1:1, 14</u></b> 1. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ... 14. And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.</p>
5	d	<p><b><u>Luke 22:42</u></b> ... saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done."</p> <p><b><u>1 John 3:16</u></b> We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us; and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.</p> <p><b><u>John 10:17-18</u></b> 17. "For this reason the Father loves Me, because I lay down My life so that I may take it again. 18. "No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father."</p> <p><b><u>1 Timothy 2:6</u></b> ...who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony <i>given</i> at the proper time.</p>
5	e	<p><b><u>Romans 7:4</u></b> Therefore, my brethren, you also were made to die to the Law through the body of Christ, so that you might be joined to another, to Him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God.</p> <p><b><u>2 Corinthians 11:2</u></b> For I am jealous for you with a godly jealousy; for I betrothed you to one husband, so that to Christ I might present you <i>as</i> a pure virgin.</p> <p><b><u>Revelation 19:7</u></b> "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready."</p>

6	<p><b><u>Hebrews 9:22</u></b> And according to the Law, <i>one may</i> almost say, all things are cleansed with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.</p> <p><b><u>Leviticus 17:11</u></b> 'For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement.'</p> <p><b><u>1 Peter 1:18-19</u></b> 18. knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, 19. but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, <i>the blood</i> of Christ.</p>
7	<p><b><u>Revelation 5</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Revelation 11:15-17</u></b> 15. Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become <i>the kingdom</i> of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever." 16. And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God, 17. saying, "We give You thanks, O Lord God, the Almighty, who are and who were, because You have taken Your great power and have begun to reign.</p> <p><b><u>Matthew 5:5</u></b> "Blessed are the gentle, for they shall inherit the earth.</p>
8	<p><b><u>Revelation 6:10</u></b> ... and they cried out with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"</p> <p><b><u>Revelation 16:6</u></b> ... for they poured out the blood of saints and prophets, and You have given them blood to drink. They deserve it."</p> <p><b><u>Revelation 19:2</u></b> BECAUSE HIS JUDGMENTS ARE TRUE AND RIGHTEOUS; for He has judged the great harlot who was corrupting the earth with her immorality, and HE HAS AVENGED THE BLOOD OF HIS BOND-SERVANTS ON HER."</p>

The RESULTS of Redemption	
<b>1</b>	<p><b><u>John 8:36</u></b> So if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed.</p> <p><b><u>Romans 6:6</u></b> ... knowing this, that our old self was crucified with <i>Him</i>, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin;</p>
<b>2</b>	<p><b><u>Revelation 1:5</u></b> ... and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who loves us and released us from our sins by His blood—</p> <p><b><u>Titus 2:14</u></b> ... who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.</p>
<b>3</b>	<p><b><u>Ephesians 1:7</u></b> In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace</p> <p><b><u>Colossians 1:14</u></b> ... in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.</p> <p><b><u>Matthew 26:28</u></b> ... for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.</p>
<b>4</b>	<p><b><u>Galatians 3:13</u></b> Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE"—</p> <p><b><u>Galatians 4:4-5</u></b> 4. But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law, 5. so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.</p> <p><b><u>1 Corinthians 15:55-56</u></b> 55. "O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY? O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING?" 56. The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law;</p> <p><b><u>Hebrews 2:15</u></b> ... and might free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives.</p> <p><b><u>Psalms 49:15</u></b> But God will redeem my soul from the power of Sheol, for He will receive me. Selah.</p>

5	<p><b><u>Colossians 1:13-14</u></b> 13. For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, 14. in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.</p> <p><b><u>Acts 26:18</u></b> ... to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.’</p>
6	<p><b><u>Galatians 4:5</u></b> ... so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.</p> <p><b><u>Hebrews 9:15</u></b> For this reason He is the mediator of a new covenant, so that, since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were <i>committed</i> under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.</p>
7	<p><b><u>Hebrews 9:11-12</u></b> 11. But when Christ appeared <i>as</i> a high priest of the good things to come, <i>He entered</i> through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation; 12. and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.</p>
8	<p><b><u>Romans 3:24</u></b> ... being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;</p>
9	<p><b><u>Revelation 5:9-10</u></b> 9. And they sang a new song, saying, “Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood <i>men</i> from every tribe and tongue and people and nation. 10. “You have made them <i>to be</i> a kingdom and priests to our God; and they will reign upon the earth.”</p>
10	<p><b><u>Titus 2:14</u></b> ... who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.</p>
11	<p><b><u>Romans 6:18,22</u></b> 18. and having been freed from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. ... 22. But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to God, you derive your benefit, resulting in sanctification, and the outcome, eternal life.</p>

In RESPONSE to Redemption:	
1-3	<p><b><u>Romans 6:11-13</u></b> 11. Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus. 12. Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its lusts, 13. and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin <i>as</i> instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members <i>as</i> instruments of righteousness to God.</p>
4-5	<p><b><u>1 Corinthians 11:24-26</u></b> 24. and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 25. In the same way <i>He took</i> the cup also after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink <i>it</i>, in remembrance of Me." 26. For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.</p>
6-7	<p><b><u>Ephesians 5:8</u></b> ... for you were formerly darkness, but now you are Light in the Lord; walk as children of Light</p> <p><b><u>Romans 13:12-14</u></b> 12. The night is almost gone, and the day is near. Therefore let us lay aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light. 13. Let us behave properly as in the day, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual promiscuity and sensuality, not in strife and jealousy. 14. But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to <i>its</i> lusts.</p>
8	<p><b><u>1 Corinthians 6:20</u></b> For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.</p>
9	<p><b><u>1 John 2:15</u></b> Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.</p> <p><b><u>Romans 12:2</u></b> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.</p> <p><b><u>James 4:4</u></b> You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.</p>

<b>10</b>	<p><b><u>Titus 2:14</u></b> ... who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.</p>
<b>11</b>	<p><b><u>Ephesians 1:14</u></b> ... who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of <i>God's own</i> possession, to the praise of His glory.</p> <p><b><u>Ephesians 4:30</u></b> Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.</p> <p><b><u>Luke 21:28</u></b> "But when these things begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."</p> <p><b><u>Romans 8:23</u></b> And not only this, but also we ourselves, having the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting eagerly for <i>our</i> adoption as sons, the redemption of our body.</p> <p><b><u>1 John 3:3</u></b> And everyone who has this hope <i>fixed</i> on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.</p>
<b>12</b>	<p><b><u>Isaiah 43:1</u></b> But now, thus says the LORD, your Creator, O Jacob, and He who formed you, O Israel, "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are Mine!"</p>
