

Forgive One Another

2	<p><u>Ephesians 4:32</u> Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.</p> <p><u>Colossians 3:12-13</u> 12. So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience; 13. bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.</p> <p><u>Romans 8:32</u> He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?</p> <p><u>Matthew 18:21-22</u> 21. Then Peter came and said to Him, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" 22. Jesus *said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven.</p>
3	<p><u>Matthew 6:9-13</u> 9. "Pray, then, in this way: 'Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. 10. 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven. 11. 'Give us this day our daily bread. 12. 'And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. 13. 'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil. [For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.]'</p>
5	<p><u>Colossians 2:13-14</u> 13. When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions, 14. having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.</p>

Matthew 18:23-35

23. "For this reason the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his slaves.
24. "When he had begun to settle *them*, one who owed him ten thousand talents was brought to him.
25. "But since he did not have *the means* to repay, his lord commanded him to be sold, along with his wife and children and all that he had, and repayment to be made.
26. "So the slave fell *to the ground* and prostrated himself before him, saying, 'Have patience with me and I will repay you everything.'
27. "And the lord of that slave felt compassion and released him and forgave him the debt.
28. "But that slave went out and found one of his fellow slaves who owed him a hundred denarii; and he seized him and *began to choke him*, saying, 'Pay back what you owe.'
29. "So his fellow slave fell *to the ground* and *began to plead* with him, saying, 'Have patience with me and I will repay you.'
30. "But he was unwilling and went and threw him in prison until he should pay back what was owed.
31. "So when his fellow slaves saw what had happened, they were deeply grieved and came and reported to their lord all that had happened.
32. "Then summoning him, his lord *said to him, 'You wicked slave, I forgave you all that debt because you pleaded with me.
33. 'Should you not also have had mercy on your fellow slave, in the same way that I had mercy on you?'
34. "And his lord, moved with anger, handed him over to the torturers until he should repay all that was owed him.
35. "My heavenly Father will also do the same to you, if each of you does not forgive his brother from your heart."

Romans 12:19

Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath *of God*, for it is written, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY," says the Lord.

Proverbs 20:22

Do not say, "I will repay evil"; wait for the LORD, and He will save you.

2 Corinthians 2:6-11

- 8
6. Sufficient for such a one is this punishment which *was inflicted* by the majority,
 7. so that on the contrary you should rather forgive and comfort *him*, otherwise such a one might be overwhelmed by excessive sorrow.
 8. Wherefore I urge you to reaffirm *your* love for him.
 9. For to this end also I wrote, so that I might put you to the test, whether you are obedient in all things.
 10. But one whom you forgive anything, I *forgive* also; for indeed what I have forgiven, if I have forgiven anything, *I did it* for your sakes in the presence of Christ,
 11. so that no advantage would be taken of us by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes.

Ephesians 4:26-27

26. BE ANGRY, AND *yet* DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger,
27. and do not give the devil an opportunity.

Matthew 18:35

 26. ["But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father who is in heaven forgive your transgressions."]

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Hebrews 12:15

See to it that no one comes short of the grace of God; that no root of bitterness springing up causes trouble, and by it many be defiled;

<p>11 & 12</p>	<p><u>Galatians 5:19-24</u> 19. Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, 20. idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, 21. envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. 22. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23. gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. 24. Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.</p> <p><u>Romans 8:12-13</u> 12. So then, brethren, we are under obligation, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh— 13. for if you are living according to the flesh, you must die; but if by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live.</p>
<p>13</p>	<p><u>Psalms 145:8</u> The LORD is gracious and merciful; slow to anger and great in lovingkindness.</p> <p><u>Luke 6:36</u> Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.</p>
<p>14</p>	<p><u>Psalms 51:12 -14</u> 12. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and sustain me with a willing spirit. 13. <i>Then</i> I will teach transgressors Your ways, and sinners will be converted to You. 14. Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, the God of my salvation; <i>then</i> my tongue will joyfully sing of Your righteousness.</p>

15	<p><u>1 John 3:10</u> By this the children of God and the children of the devil are obvious: anyone who does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor the one who does not love his brother.</p> <p><u>1 John 4:20</u> If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen.</p> <p><u>1 John 5:3</u> For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome.</p> <p><u>John 14:15</u> If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.</p>
16	<p><u>Psalm 138:8</u> The LORD will accomplish what concerns me; Your lovingkindness, O LORD, is everlasting; do not forsake the works of Your hands.</p> <p><u>Romans 8:28</u> And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to <i>His</i> purpose.</p> <p><u>Philippians 1:6</u> <i>For I am</i> confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.</p>
