What happens through or by faith?	How is faith seen?	Foundational Faith Facts
Through or by faith: 1. I am saved (Eph 2:8; Rom 1:16; 1 Tim 4:9-10) 2. I entered into rest (salvation) (Heb 4:1-3) 3. I received the forgiveness of sins (Acts 10:43) 4. my heart was cleansed and purified (Acts 15:9) 5. I have been justified and I now have peace with God (Rom 5:1) 6. I have eternal life in Jesus (Jn 20:31, 14:6; 1 Jn 5:10-11) 7. I have become a child of God (Jn 1:12-13; Gal 3:26) 8. I was raised up with Christ (Col 2:12) 9. Jesus Christ dwells in my heart (Eph 3:16-17) 10. I have bold and confident access to the Father (Eph 2:18, 3:12) 11. I have gained access into the grace in which I now stand (Rom 5:1-2) 12. I am able to stand firm (persevere) (2 Cor 1:24) 13. I am sanctified (Acts 26:17-18) 14. I obey God (Rom 1:5, 16:26) 15. I understand what can not be naturally understood (e.g. the creation) (Heb 11:3)	Faith is seen when: 1. people turn to God (Acts 11:19-21) 2. I bring to Jesus my need and work hard at overcoming the obstacles and challenges (Mk 2:3-5) 3. I persevere, standing on the truth even in the face of discouragement or apparent failure (Mt 15:22-28) 4. I promptly and joyfully obey God just because He has commanded – even when I don't know His purposes or what the outcome might be (Heb 11:8) 5. I do not waver with respect to the Word of God and my faith grows stronger even in the face of obvious impossibilities (Rom 4:18-21) 6. I am willing to give back to the Lord what He has given to me so that nothing but He may have my heart's whole love and devotion (Heb 11:17-19) 7. I steadfastly persist on the path of obedience without fear because I "see" Him who is invisible (Heb 11:27) 8. I sacrifice a temporary, transient benefit for an eternal permanent reward (Heb 11:24-26)	1. Faith, both saving faith and living faith, is ultimately from God (Eph 2:8-9; Acts 14:27) 2. Faith pleases God and without faith it is impossible to please Him (Heb 11:6) 3. Our faith is the victory that has, and continues to overcome the world (1 Jn 5:4) 4. The righteous person will live his life by faith (Rom 1:17; Gal 3:11; Heb 10:38) 5. Our goal is a sincere faith (1 Tim 1:5; 2 Tim 1:5) 6. Faith comes and grows by the word of God (Rom 10:17; 1 Pet 2:2-3) 7. God has allotted to each believer the exact measure of faith required to exercise his/her spiritual gift for serving the body of Christ (Rom 12:1-6) 8. Those who are weaker in the faith must not judge and those who are stronger in faith must not condemn or show contempt (Rom 14:1-5, 10) 9. Devoted to one another in love, believers comfort, encourage and strengthen each other by their faith (Rom 1:11-12; Gal 6:10; 1 Thess 3:7)
